In English, the possessive adjectives his, her, and their tell whether something belongs to a male, a female, or more than one person In Spanish, the possessive adjective su has many possible meanings (his, her, its, your, their)

Possessive adjectives are my, your, his, her, its, our, their Possessive adjectives occur before a noun (my car) or an adjective + noun (my new car) Rule 3 Possessive adjectives have no singular or plural They are used with both singular and plural nouns (my book, my books) BE CAREFUL! Possessive Adjectives in English

Possessive Adjectives in English Possessive adjectives are used in English to refer to the ownership or possession of something When we use them to talk about a person, it is more in the sense of a relationship with that person English possessive adjectives: my your his / her / its (not it's!) our your

Subject Pronouns and Possessive Adjectives What are subject pronouns? Subject pronouns are words that replace the noun Ex: Maria is from Colombia She is from Colombia María and I work at Costco We work at Costco You, your father and your dog

Possessive, relative and indefinite pronouns worksheet
